Department of anesthesiology provides perioperative services for one of the country's busiest solid organ transplantation programs with over 160 liver transplants and over 60 kidney transplants per year. Further, the Department's expertise spans over anesthesia for high-acuity surgery (e.g., major vascular surgery, polytrauma), hepato-pancreato-biliary surgery, general and colorectal surgery as well as urological, orthopedic, obstetric, and gynecological procedures. Department of Intensive Care and Resuscitation provides interventional critical care services, together with the medical emergency response/code teams' involvement. In total, the department manages 24 intensive care unit (ICU) beds: the Surgical ICU (15 beds) and the Covid ICU (9 beds).
