

Clinical Trial Network Centre Registration:

One person of an Institution willing to join as a centre in one of the Clinical Trial Network study is required to provide an **ESA membership number** on the 'Call for Centre form'.

Local Coordinator is asked to provide one current ESA membership per institution (any types of membership are accepted: active, associate, affiliate, trainee, etc.)

The Research Committee members suggest that either the **local Principal Investigator** or the **Head of the department** (preferably both and even more colleagues from the department) become a member of European Society of Anaesthesiology so that the research publication of the study will have as collaborators at least one ESA member per Clinical Trial Network (CTN) centre.

Advantages open to ESA members only:

- The ESA Grant Programmes (Research Grant, Young Teaching Recognition Award and Trainee Exchange Programme)
- Receive the eNews by email
- Have full access to all features of the ESA internet site
- Get leadership and volunteer opportunities as ESA active members
- Receive a printed version of the European Journal of Anaesthesiology (EJA)
- Full Electronic Access to the EJA, but also full electronic access to "Current Opinion in Anesthesiology" and "Current Opinion in Critical Care"
- Reduced Congress fee for ESA Euroanaesthesia Congress.

Rates:

Yearly ESA [membership rate](#) is as low as 35,- € for Trainee, Student or Retired members, or 40,- € for Active Member from a reduced fee country; and 75,- € for active member non reduced fee countries (120,- € for two years). Thus, visiting Euroanaesthesia congress every other year as active member will cover by itself the membership fee. - your National Society is member of the ESA.
- your National Society communicated you the details on the ESA Associate membership.

Specialist Societies Membership

Specialist areas of anaesthesiology, critical care, emergency medicine and pain management are already represented in the ESA as subcommittees of the Scientific Programme Committee. Unfortunately, **being a member of a Specialist Society does not result in a reduced fee or free ESA individual membership.** ESA associate membership and 'umbrella' is only for the 'European National Societies' not for 'Specialist' Societies.
